



If you do not already have an account, you will need to sign up for an account by clicking JOIN NOW




Once you have logged in, you can navigate to the training by going to Training & Safety



Then select Online Learning




The link will bring you to the page where all their training materials are- next select Online Course, which will auto navigate you to the correct section


Once through the Intro, Pilot & Airplane and Passengers sections, you will come to the Track Selection.

Once the training is completed and the Quiz is passed with 80% or better, the training will generate a certificate.




Click on Get Certificate, then on the following screen select Generate Certificate
