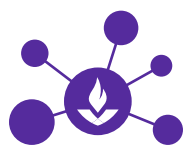

 - Undergraduate Degree: \$341 for one 3-credit-hour class plus fees

AVIATION

- MGA is home to Georgia's flagship aviation school, the only public 4-year aviation school in the state
- Industry-serving programs include professional flight, aviation management, aviation maintenance technology, air traffic management and aircraft structural technology
- Bachelor of Science degree in Aviation Science & Management-Advanced Flight degree accredited by **Aviation Accrediting Board International (AABI)**, becoming the first degree program in Georgia to earn this recognition
- Academic credit awarded for certain FAA licenses
- Flight instruction offered on the University's Eastman Campus and its satellite location at the Herbert Smart/Macon Downtown Airport

- MGA's first doctoral degree, introduced in 2021, is the **Doctor of Science in Information Technology**, which is designed to produce graduates prepared to assume leadership roles and manage information technology and systems within organizations.
