**TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**

February 10, 2015

**Agreement in Principle**

This agreement formally recognizes that Middle Georgia State College (MGA) and Georgia Military College (GMC) are committed to the establishment of an educational partnership to better serve currently enrolled and future students at both institutions. Both parties agree to exercise due diligence in providing as smooth a transition as possible for students who elect to transfer to MGA from GMC.

**Agreement on Accreditation**

This agreement is contingent upon the continuation of all appropriate program and institutional accreditations, including the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools-Commission on Colleges (SACS-COC) and those from professional bodies.

**Agreement on Admission**

Any GMC student who graduates from Georgia Military College with an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree (Attachments A and B) is guaranteed admission into Middle Georgia State College provided that the student has a GPA of 2.0 out of a 4.0 scale for all college course work attempted. The guarantee of admission is to MGSC only and does not guarantee acceptance into specific majors or programs that are competitively based or that have admission requirements beyond the minimum for the institution.

**Agreement on Acceptance of Transfer Credit**

Middle Georgia State College accepts transfer credit in accordance with the policies, rules and practices of the University System of Georgia, SACS-COC and its mission as a comprehensive state institution. The MGA course equivalency is determined by the appropriate department and is based on criteria such as course content, course outcomes and the level at which the course is taught. Transfer credit is processed by the Admissions Office and recorded by the Registrar.

Courses transferred from Georgia Military College with a common course name and number are guaranteed to transfer if those same courses are included in the MGA curriculum.

In addition, a student who transfers from Georgia Military College with an accredited Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will transfer into MGA with Areas A-E of the Core complete. Please note that Middle Georgia State College has specific requirements for the two laboratory science classes required in Area D. For maximization of transfer credits, see Attachment C or contact the admissions department at MGSC. Students who have not completed core or pre-requisites for admission to specific majors or programs of study at MGA will be required to complete them before being considered for admission into a specific major or program of study. GMC transfer students may complete such requirements at MGA.

**Agreement on Communication**


Middle Georgia State College and Georgia Military College agree to cooperate in the publication and promotion of the articulation agreement between the two schools. Both parties will facilitate the dissemination of information about this program to interested and qualified students, with both institutions providing counseling and advisement.

**Agreement on Maintenance and Review**

At least one administrator or faculty member from each institution will be appointed to act as a primary point of contact and agent for the implementation of this agreement, to speak for the institutions, and to communicate details and modifications to respective faculty members, advisors, counselors, and others to whom the information is pertinent. Responsibility for oversight of this agreement rests with the Registrar at GMC and the Registrar at MGA.

This agreement is open to all GMC students regardless of race, color, religion, gender, age, creed, national origin or disability. Review and communication of degree content changes will be completed on an annual basis. Additional degrees may be added to this agreement upon formal request. This agreement will be automatically renewed unless one of the parties notifies the other of its desire to terminate the agreement. Such notification must be in writing and submitted six months in advance with the effective date to coincide with the last day of the academic term under which it falls.
