

Summer Scholars 2019: Global Georgia

The **Summer Scholars Program** enables academically motivated **new freshmen** at Middle Georgia State University to get a jump start on their college career in an immersive living-learning community. Students earn six hours of core curriculum credit through four weeks of online summer instruction and a month-long, high-impact residential experience, culminating in an international exploration in Costa Rica.

Benefits of the Summer Scholars Program

- Membership in a residential community of student scholars with year-long programming.
- Priority access to MGA housing on the Macon and Cochran campuses.
- Access to honors courses and a gateway to the MGA Honors program.
- **Participation in the Experiential Learning@MGA program.**
- **Weekly travel across Georgia and an optional international experience in Costa Rica.**
- **Eligible students can use Hope and Zell Miller scholarships, Pell grants, or student loans.**

The 2019 theme is **Global Georgia**. Students will explore their connections to Georgia, the world, and each other by completing two thematically related core curriculum courses. Classes will feature weekly on-site lectures at internationally significant Georgia sites. Outside of class, participants will benefit from an advance introduction to the university's resources and a chance to build their support network of faculty, staff, and fellow students. Courses offered on the program are

- POLS 2401 Global Issues
- HUMN 1009 Perspectives on Global Culture
- HUMN 2151 Special Topics: The Stories We Tell
- HUMN 1001 Perspectives on Narrative

Students may add online courses as needed.

Eligibility and How To Apply

The Summer Scholars program is **highly selective**, with very limited availability. Students must have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 and be admitted to Middle Georgia State University for summer 2019.
