

Advising Students with Special Student Status

Transient Student: A transient student is a student who seeks temporary admission to a college and transfers the credit back to their home college.

Special Student: Applicants who have an associate's or higher degree from an accredited institution of higher education and who do not wish to pursue another degree may enroll as a Special Student.

Policy :

1. All course pre-requisites are in effect regardless of the admission status.
2. If a Transient or Special Student wants to take a course with a pre or co-requisite, the student must be advised and registered through the department that offers the course.
3. Any advisor can assist the student with schedule building and registration.
