ENGL 6300: Teaching First Year Composition (3 hours)
ENGL 6400: Teaching Developmental Writing (3 hours)
ENGL 6500: Teaching Online Research and Writing (3 hours)

Students who are not currently active educators should take:

• ENGL 5900: Graduate Internship (3 hours)

This course should be taken in the same semester as either ENGL 6300, ENGL 6400, or ENGL 6500

Students who are currently active educators may choose to take one of the following courses instead of ENGL 5900:

- ENGL 5106: Technical Writing in the Digital Age (3 hours)
- ENGL 5206: Public and Professional Writing (3 hours)
