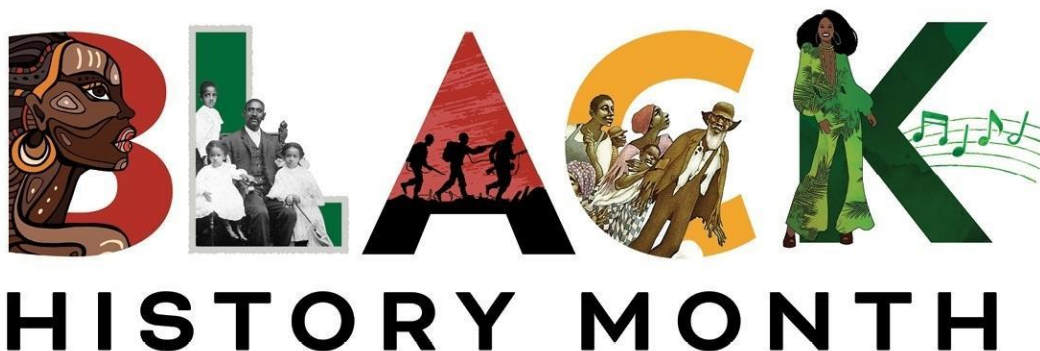


African American History, Heritage, & Culture
