**Earn a grade of “C” or higher in the English, Math and the PSYC 1101, BIOL 2251, BIOL 2252 and BIOL 2260 courses.**

**Satisfy:** Have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 and hold an unrestricted RN license. It is suggested that students pursuing a BSN degree complete one of the following lab science sequences: BIOL 1001-1002, BIOL 2107-2108, CHEM 1151-1152, CHEM 1211-1212, PHYS 1111-1112, or PHYS 2211-2212 and MATH 1401 as the Stem Elective. It is also suggested that students take PSYC 1101 as a Social Science Elective. Not completing the recommended course may require additional credit hour accrual. Meet with your Academic Advisor at least once per semester.
