IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER MGSU Water System Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Nitrates

Our Community Water System (CWS) violated drinking water standard. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. From 04/22 to 12/31/2022, we did not monitor or test for Nitrates and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should You do? There is nothing you need to do at this time.

What is being done?

The University contracts its lab testing with the State EPD Lab. They send bottles for us to collect annually. We did not receive the sample kit, so the testing was not done. Either it was not shipped or UPS did not deliver. We just received our kit for 2023 and it will sampled this month. Our source of water is groundwater and in the past, Nitrates have been very low.
