



Federal Financial Aid for Transient Study

Students may be eligible to use federal financial aid while attending another University System of Georgia (USG) institution as a transient student. Students participating in an approved Study Abroad program at a non-USG institution may also be eligible to use their federal financial aid with approval from the MGA Office of Financial Aid.

If you wish to do this, please read the following information and return this completed form to the Office of Financial Aid. Financial aid eligibility may be adjusted based on the host institution's cost of attendance, enrollment status, and/or the type of coursework for which you are enrolled.

1. Submit Required Documentation

Attach a copy of your approved Transient Permission/Letter of Good Standing from the Registrar's Office. The courses you take at the host institution must apply toward your degree program at MGA. If you are participating in a Study Abroad program, additional documentation may be requested by the MGA Office of Financial Aid.

2. Financial Aid Approval and Consortium Agreement

Once your request is received and approved by the MGA Office of Financial Aid, a Consortium Agreement will be sent to the host institution. The host institution must certify your enrollment and return the completed Consortium Agreement before federal financial aid funds can be disbursed.

3. Payment Responsibilities

You are responsible for making payment directly to the host institution. Any federal student aid for which you are eligible will be disbursed to your student account at MGA.

4. Proof of Payment

You must provide proof of payment to the MGA Office of Financial Aid.

5. Official Transcript and Enrollment Changes

You must ensure that an official academic transcript is sent to MGA from the host institution upon completion of your coursework. Your transcript must be received and posted before additional financial aid funds can be disbursed, if applicable. If you withdraw from any course(s) at the host institution, you must immediately notify the MGA Office of Financial Aid and provide documentation indicating your last date of attendance. Failure to report enrollment changes may affect your financial aid eligibility.
