The MGA Doctor of Science in Public Safety (DSPS) is a graduate program that prepares individuals to serve as managers in the executive arm of local, state, and federal government and that focuses on the systematic study of executive organization and management. The program is designed to serve current professionals within the field who have interest in advancing into leadership roles within their respective area.

- The DSPS program requires students to complete 54 hours of graduate coursework.
- All courses are offered online.
- Students may complete the program on a full-time or part-time basis.
- Students choose between two concentrations in the degree:  
Emergency and Disaster Management or Security and Analytics.
- This unique doctoral program merges the practice of public safety with the research capabilities of higher education to provide a holistic approach to in-service training.
