

Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) Program Information

MGA Nursing programs are competitive.

You will be accepted to MGA and subsequently accepted into the nursing program.

Overview: The Department of Nursing offers the ASN for students who want to become registered nurses and earn an associate's degree. Each semester, the Admissions Recruitment and Retention committee selects up to 60 qualified candidates to join the ASN program. All students intending to pursue the ASN program should strive to earn strong grades in all subjects especially science and avoid D/F grades, patterns of withdrawal and disruptive behavior.

ASN cohorts rotate admission locations each semester – Fall Admission (Cochran) and Spring Admission (Dublin). Please keep in mind that the Nursing curriculum is very rigorous and does not allow a lot of flexibility with scheduling given the hours for clinical and labs.

Minimum Requirements for competitive admission to the ASN program. Each applicant must:

- be a current student and in Good Academic Standing.
- have a 2.50 overall Grade Point Average.
- have a 2.50 nursing core curriculum Grade Point Average.
- o score 64 or above on the TEAS Entrance Exam.
- have completed Area A, BIOL 2251 and BIOL 2252.
- submit an online application and TEAS score prior to the application deadline.
