This is the first assessment cycle for the BA-AAD and there is no benchmark from a previous assessment cycle for comparison. N=1 or 50% of the students did not demonstrate mastery of this SLO. This is the first time the course was offered, and assessment of a small sample size (n=2) is problematic for making assumptions for student success. 4.0 on the rubric is the mark for mastery. The student who did not achieve mastery scored a 3.75 total rubric score, and achieved a score of 4 on ¾ of the rubric markers. It is recommended that an SLI be applied to this SLO for AY 2023 and will be detailed below.
