Financial Aid is applicable to study abroad. Under most federal programs, the amount of grant or loan money for which a student is eligible can be increased to cover additional costs of studying abroad. Awards of financial aid for study abroad are based, in part, on financial need and the level of a student's need is measured by a formal evaluation process. As soon as you choose your program and know its cost, visit the financial aid office to begin that evaluation process.

MGA Scholarships: The MGA Foundation awards scholarships earmarked for study abroad. Look for application information and deadlines from the Foundation in January.
