


# **Designations & New Programs**

The Cybersecurity Program was re-designated by Center for Academic Excellence (CAE) in Cyber Defense Education. We are recognized by the NSA as a Center for Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense Education.

Launched both bachelor's and associate's degrees in computer science in fall 2023. Both programs are off red face-to-face on Warner Robins Campus.

### **Grants Received**

The School of Computing received 2 grants with a combining total of \$45,000 from the E.J. Grassman Trust and the Affordable Learning Grant.
