Process for finding study materials for any class

- 1) Check the SSC Website for videos and Internet links: call 478-471-2057 (Macon) or 478-929-6770 (Warner Robins) for passwords
- 2) Check the Macon Campus Library for materials in the reserve section (instructor solution manuals, citation guides, etc.)
- 3) Check the back of your textbook for additional websites for study resources
- 4) Check the Middle Georgia State University Campus Store for study guides and student solution manuals
- 5) Check this handout for additional resources and ask an SSC tutor for extra study tips

Resources for Mathematics
