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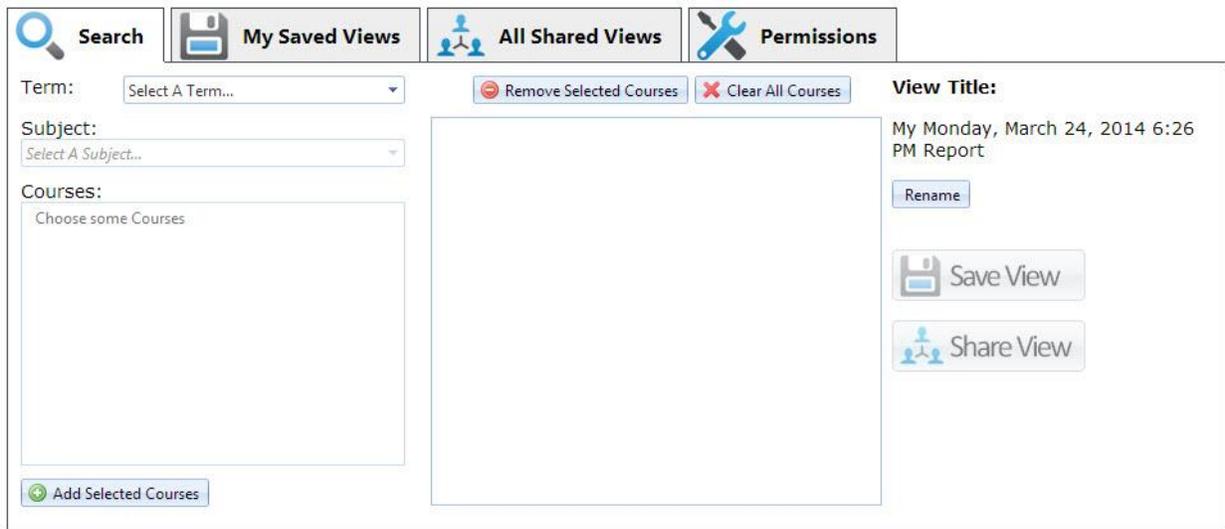
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Enrollment Optimization Engine

The Enrollment Optimization Engine (EO) is a system designed to preference the order in which schedules are displayed in the view schedule page. Schedules that contain sections with higher Priority are displayed earlier in the Generate Schedules pane. You can access the EO tool from the admin panel by clicking the Enrollment Optimization Engine link.

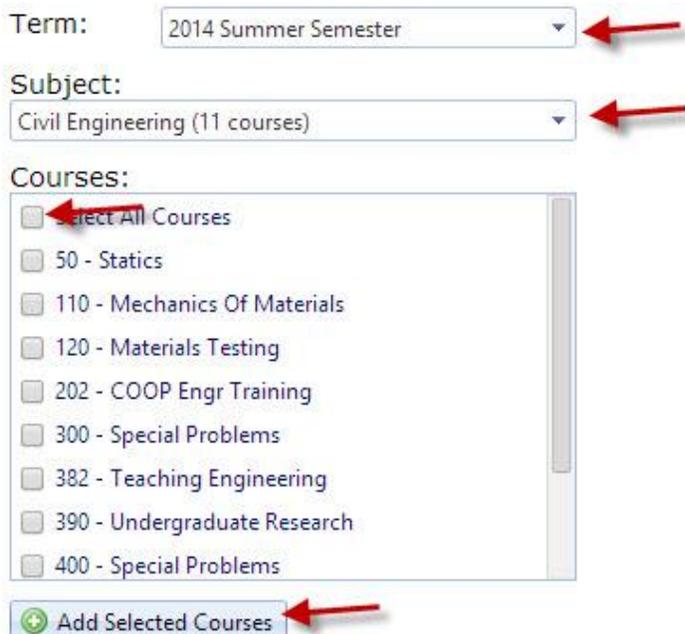

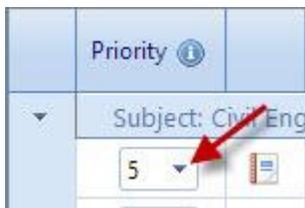

3) Set a higher or lower priority for each section by using the Priority pull-down menu.



A higher number will cause schedules that include that section to appear earlier in the Generate Schedules pane. Setting a lower number will cause schedules to appear later in the Generate Schedules pane.

4) Set the checkmark of courses you would like to save in the course pane.



5) Save the view.

2) Choose to share your view under the Sharing column using the drop down.
